Shuttle services will be offered from two locations free of charge. South Eugene High School and Autzen Stadium will serve as Park & Ride locations during the eight-day event at no cost to those with an event ticket. Spectators, media professionals, and athletes will be transported from these locations to the front of Hayward Field on Agate Street on the University of Oregon campus. In addition, LTD's popular and free EmX Green Line will offer enhanced service to its Agate Station only two blocks away from Hayward Field.
